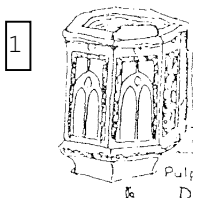
This is the church of All Saints. Some churches are named after just one saint. Can you think of any in the local area?

This church is not named after just one saint but after ALL of them. There are lots of saints in the building. Which ones can you find? Write their names here:

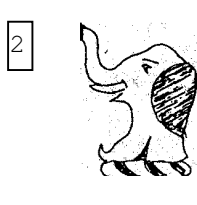
Saints are people who live good Christian lives. What do you think their lives were like? What do you think they did?

Church Layout

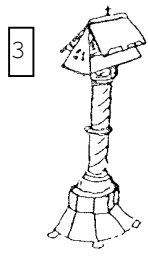
Here are some of the features we have looked at and a plan of the church? Can you mark where the features are?



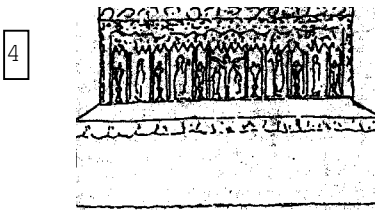

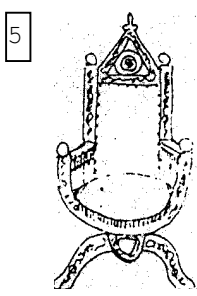
Lord Carrington's Elephant



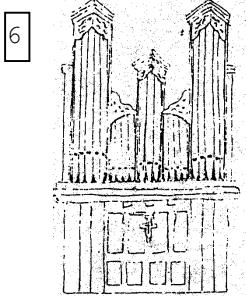

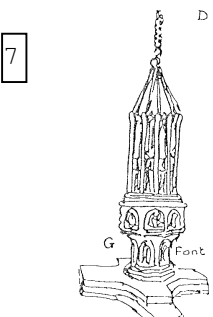

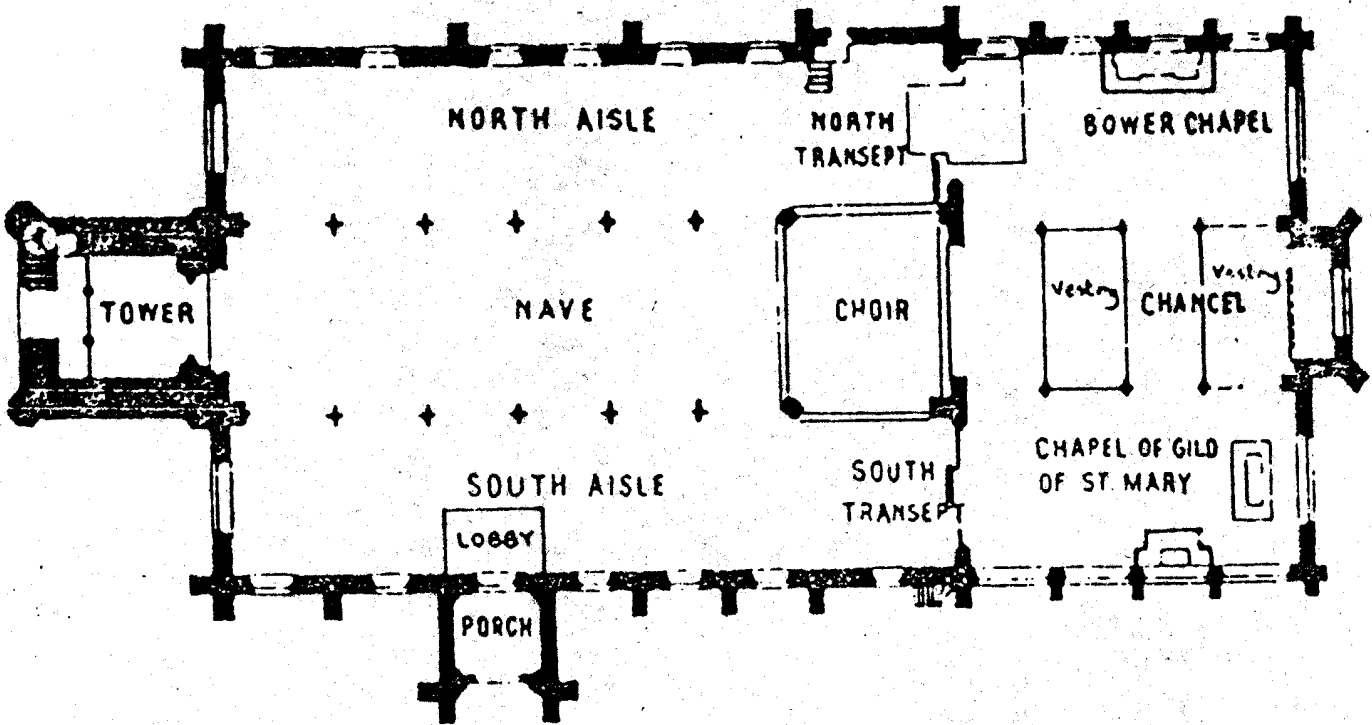

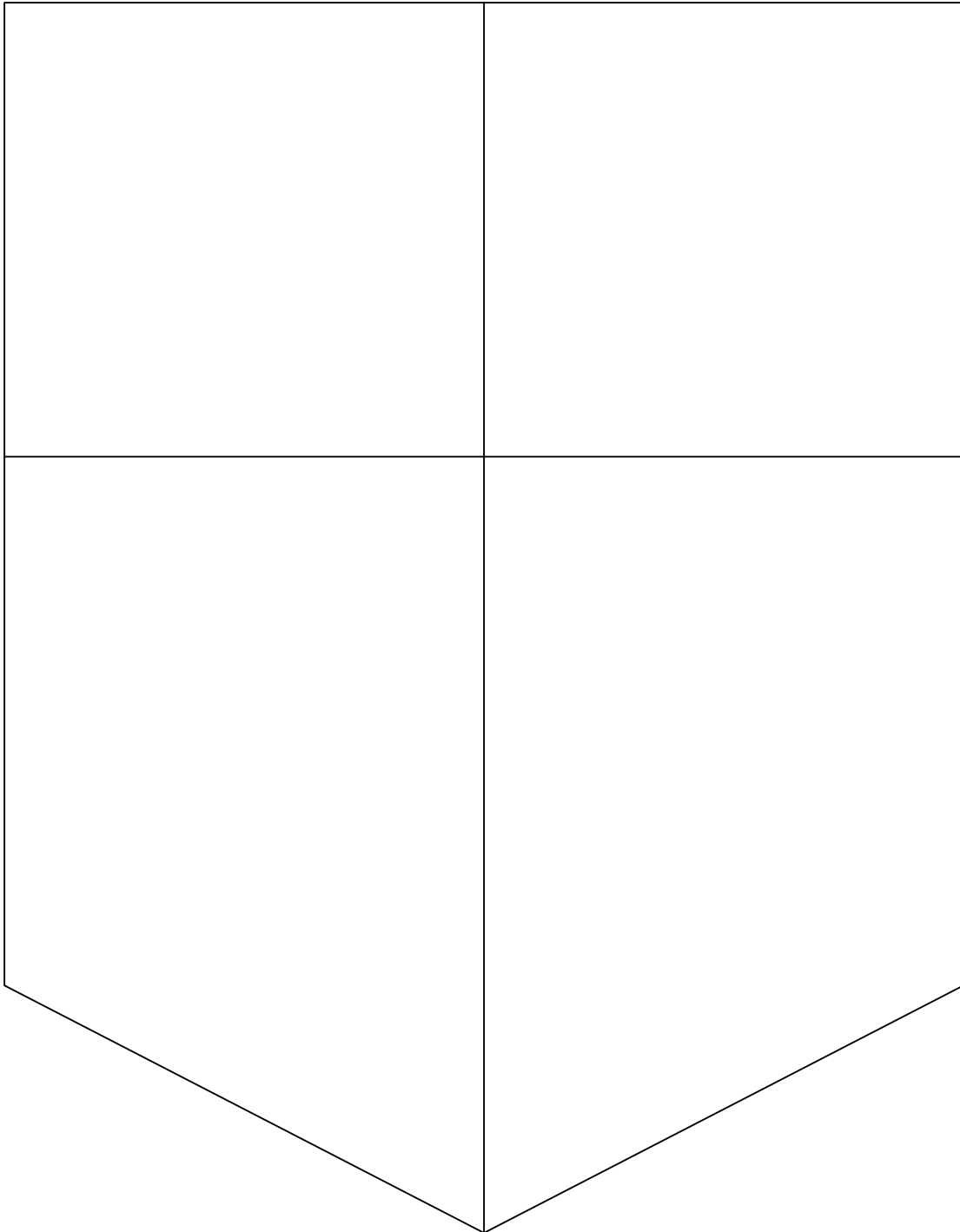

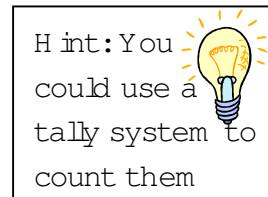
Coat of Arms
