

July 2021: Public Worship at All Saints following updated Government and Church of England guidance



The information below is intended to help you feel both welcome and safe at All Saints:

IMPORTANT: please do not visit the church if you are feeling unwell or experiencing COVID-19 symptoms – stay at home and self-isolate

Communal worship

- there is no need to pre-book a seat for any of our services

When you arrive, you will be invited to:

- use the hand sanitiser provided
- wear a face covering – this is a personal choice, but we are currently encouraging the use of masks when near others
- check in using the QR code by the door which enables you to be contacted via NHS track and trace if others attending test positive for COVID-19. Paper forms will also be available
- pick up a service sheet
- make your way to a seat in the nave, the north aisle (including children & families activity area) or if you would prefer socially distanced seating, please sit in the south aisle

During the service:

- enjoy the congregational singing!
- be aware that some will not wish to physically share the peace with people outside their household
- during communion those in the nave and north aisle will be invited to queue and receive in the centre. For the moment only bread will be distributed, and we encourage you to wear a face mask. Communion will be brought to those in the south aisle.
- to aid ventilation, at least one door will be open at the west end

At the end:

- please take your service sheet with you
- there will be post service refreshments on 25 July, but probably not during August
- you are welcome to join Zoom coffee via the Sunday service link on our website
- if you test positive after visiting the building, we would be grateful if you would notify the parish office
