

**July 2020: Public Worship at All Saints following
Government and Church of England guidance**
Version 4 – updated 07/08/20 re face coverings



The information below is intended to help you feel both welcome and safe at All Saints:

IMPORTANT: please do not visit the church if you are feeling unwell or experiencing COVID-19 symptoms – stay at home and self-isolate

By 1pm each Friday:

- to help us manage numbers, let us know how many seats we should reserve for your household/bubble – email office@allsaintshighwycombe.org or call 01494 527526 . We will ask for your name and telephone number which will be kept for 21 days so you can be contacted as part of NHS test and trace if others attending test positive for COVID-19

When you arrive please:

- use the main entrance as usual – we will open the doors 20 minutes before the service starts
- maintain social distancing of 2m while you wait until the entrance is clear
- **put on your face covering** – this is now required by law unless you are exempt
- use the hand sanitiser provided
- give your name and telephone number if asked. This information will be kept for 21 days so you can be contacted as part of NHS track and trace if others attending test positive for COVID-19
- **wait** to be greeted by a sidesperson and shown to your seat. We have a limited capacity and the chairs have been spaced to conform with social distancing

During the service:

- service sheets will be available but if you are able to print and bring your own copy that would be great. Please do not share your service sheet with others
- follow the instructions given by the priest. During communion please remain in your seat as the clergy will come to you. Only bread will be distributed
- do not physically share the peace or physically greet others
- group singing is not currently allowed so please simply listen and enjoy the music. The psalm and alleluia will be sung by a Cantor
- to aid ventilation, the entrance doors will remain open

At the end:

- please leave the building promptly when directed and take your service sheet with you
- there will be no refreshments available onsite but please join Zoom coffee when you get home via the Sunday service link on our website
- maintain social distancing of 2m if you wish to catch up with others outside
- let us know if you test positive for COVID-19 up to 21 days after the service

Donations can be made using the contactless card reader or box by the entrance. There are also online options and the details can be found in the news sheet and on our website.
