**1. Appointment of two elected members to the Standing Committee**

**5. Proposed Resolution for the Adoption of Accounts**

The Secretary announced that 14 out of a possible 20 votes had been cast in response to the written request to approve the 2022 Trustees Report and Accounts, with no objections or abstentions. Hence the Resolution had been approved.
