## Gift Aid

*Do you pay Income Tax, or Capital Gains Tax?*

*Do you want to support All Saints' church?*

*Do you want All Saints' to gain an additional 25 pence for every one pound you give?*

If you have answered 'Yes' to all these questions you can make your gifts using the Gift Aid scheme.

(See **Gift Aid Notes** overleaf)

### What do I need to do?

**"Very Little"** - All that you need to do is to sign and date the Declaration overleaf and fill in your **full name, address and postcode in block capitals** - this enables HM Revenue & Customs to identify you as the donor.

If you pay higher rate tax, you need to keep a record of the dates and sums of all gifts under the Gift Aid scheme and include them in your next Self-Assessment tax return (data available from the Gift Aid Secretary).

### Is the information kept confidential?

**"Yes"** - You do not need to disclose details of your income or tax affairs; these remain your private affair. Once signed, All Saints' church keeps the declaration. We are then able to recover tax on your gifts, at no extra cost to you. Your giving information will only be seen by those administering the Planned Giving Schemes

### How can I make my gifts?

1. The easiest way is to set up a Standing Order: our bank details are on the "Banker's Order", or you can complete the form & return it to us.
2. Alternatively, you can give regular offerings using cash or cheques by asking for a supply of the All Saints' Stewardship Envelopes.
3. You can donate one-off gifts using a cheque on your personal bank account (with a completed gift aid declaration if appropriate) and sending it to the PCC Treasurer with this form or place the cheque and form in one of the yellow offering envelopes.

## Gift Aid Notes

1. Please notify the Parish Administrator at the Church Office if you change your name or address whilst the Gift Aid Declaration is still in force.
2. You can cancel the Declaration at any time by notifying the Parish Administrator. We will then cease recovering tax from the HM Revenue & Customs via the Gift Aid scheme.
3. You must notify All Saints' PCC (Hon Treasurer) if you no longer pay sufficient tax on your income and/or capital gains.

### Higher Rate taxpayers and those receiving tax rebates

4. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can personally recover a further 25 pence for every £1.00 you give.
5. If you pay Income Tax at the higher or additional rate and want to receive the additional tax relief due to you, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self-Assessment tax return or ask HM Revenue and Customs to adjust your tax code.
6. By using the HM Revenue and Customs' unique reference number for our PCC ([083PN00003615), you can not only direct your recovered tax to our Church but, because HM Revenue & Customs recognises this allocation as a further gift, they will add an additional 20% Gift Aid benefit. This could enable us to recover as much as 58 pence for every £1.00 you give.
