

Unseen Echoes: New Photography Exhibition on Domestic Abuse Opens at All Saints Parish Church, High Wycombe 24th October to the 8th of November 2024

High Wycombe, UK – The CJHF (Christopher James Hall Foundation) is honoured to present "Unseen Echoes," a compelling photography exhibition addressing the complex and often hidden issue of domestic abuse. The exhibition will run from 24th October to the 8th of November 2024 at All Saints Parish Church, High Wycombe.

"Unseen Echoes" sheds light on the silent suffering experienced by victims of domestic abuse. Through a series of evocative images, award-winning photographer Christopher James Hall reveals the emotional and physical impact of abuse, as well as the strength and resilience of those who have survived it. The exhibition seeks to break the silence around domestic abuse, encouraging open conversations and greater understanding of this pervasive issue.

Christopher James Hall, founder of the CJHF, explains, "Domestic abuse is often hidden behind closed doors, leaving survivors feeling voiceless and unseen. 'Unseen Echoes' is about bringing those stories into the light, showing the courage it takes to survive, and the strength it takes to speak out. Our hope is that this exhibition will raise awareness, foster empathy, and inspire action."

The exhibition is the result of collaborative efforts between CJHF and several organisations that provide support to individuals affected by domestic abuse. By sharing real stories through photography, "Unseen Echoes" aims to highlight the need for continued support and advocacy for survivors.
